Executive Director's Message – 2023 Utah Operation Lifesaver Annual Summary

Another year has passed, and Utah Operation Lifesaver has summarized the data for 2023. While statistics do not tell the entire story, data provides valuable information for us to evaluate what happened in 2023. One of the four E's for Utah Operation Lifesaver and National Rail Safety Alliance is "Evaluation." Rail safety in Utah for 2023 was about the same as last year. Table 1 shows the highway-rail grade crossing and trespass incidents for both the United States and Utah. In addition to freight and tourist rail, the statistics below include UTA TRAX light-rail and FrontRunner commuter rail numbers for Utah.
